50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 41% Merlot, 9% Cabernet Franc

in the vineyard

This special blend is a selection of grapes from specific vineyard blocks on the farm that were managed to give this wine its specific style.

in the cellar

During winemaking the cultivars were kept apart and aged in third fill 300 litre French oak and in stainless steel tanks with staves. After 12 months the different components were blended after rigorous tasting sessions with our Old Man, Peter Pentz.
